DESCRIPTION (field, expectations, comments):

The candidates have to conform to the conditions stated in art. 113 of Higher Education Law dated 20.07.2018 (Journal of Laws of the Republic of Poland 2024, item 1571 with further amendments).

We are looking for a candidate for a researcher for the NCN project entitled "Shedding Light on the Dark Milky Way: from Dark Matter to Astrophysical Black Holes" No. UMO-2023/51/D/ST9/00187 carried out by Dr. Przemysław Mróz at the Astronomical Observatory of the University of Warsaw. We offer full-time employment under an employment contract of up to 24 months, no longer than until October 1, 2027. In the event of an extension of the project, employment extension is possible.

Requirements:

- PhD in Astronomy or Astrophysics,
- experience in modeling gravitational microlensing events, supported by publications in referred journals,
- experience in working with photometric data,
- ability to work in a team.

In addition, experience with using the *Gaia* data will be an advantage.

Key responsibilities:

The main goal of the project is to use gravitational microlensing as a tool for searching for and studying neutron stars and black holes. The candidate will analyze observations of gravitational microlensing events collected by the OGLE survey (photometric data) and the Gaia satellite (photometric and astrometric data). The candidate is expected to publish their results in refereed journals and collaborate with the project team.

Conditions of employment:

Employment under a full-time fixed-term employment contract. The preferred start date of the employment is August 1st, 2025. Work at the Astronomical Observatory of the University of Warsaw, Al. Ujazdowskie 4, 00-478 Warszawa.

Additional information:

The candidate must meet the conditions established by the National Science Center for people employed in a post-doc position. In particular, the person employed in this position obtained a doctoral degree in the year of employment in the project or in the period of 7 years before January 1 of the year of employment in the project. This period may be extended by the time spent on long-term (over 90 days) documented sickness benefits or rehabilitation benefits due to incapacity for work. Additionally, this period may be extended by the number of months spent on leave related to the care and upbringing of children granted on the terms set out in the Labor Code, and, in the case of women - by 18 months for each born or adopted child, if this method of indicating breaks in a scientific career is more favourable. The employment will take place in accordance with the NCN regulations, in particular, the employed person must meet all of the following conditions:

- the project manager was not the supervisor or auxiliary supervisor of her doctoral dissertation;
- obtained a doctoral degree in an entity other than the entity where employment in this position is planned, or completed at least 10 months of continuous and documented postdoctoral internship in an entity other than the entity implementing the project and in a country other than the country of obtaining the doctoral degree;
- during the period of receiving this remuneration, he will not receive any other remuneration from funds allocated as direct costs from research projects financed in NCN calls;
- during the period of receiving this remuneration, he will not receive remuneration from another employer under an employment contract, including from an employer based outside Poland;
- during the period of receiving this remuneration, he will not receive retirement benefits from the social security system;
- will be employed for a period of not less than 6 months.

Documents 1-3 should be signed. In the case of e-mail applications, they must be sent in PDF format with a scanned signature.

When applying for employment, the selected candidate is obliged to submit original documents.

The competition will be concluded by April 1, 2025. The candidates will be notified individually by e-mail about the date of a possible interview with the Faculty Council competition committee.

Candidates will be notified of the competition results by e-mail.

The competition is the first stage of the employment procedure for the position of an academic teacher, and its positive result constitutes the basis for further proceedings.

Data retention period
